Introduction

The Florida Department of Health is pleased to release the results of the 2022 Florida Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) Adverse Childhood Experience (ACE) module. The Florida BRFSS is a statewide telephone survey that provides the only source of state-specific, population-based estimates of the prevalence of various health conditions and related risk behaviors by Florida residents aged 18 and older. The purpose of this survey is to gather information regarding personal health and risk behaviors, selected medical conditions, and preventive health care practices by Florida adults. These data are used to: (1) determine priority health issues and identify populations at risk for illness, disability, and death; (2) plan and evaluate prevention programs; (3) educate the community and policy makers about disease prevention; and (4) support community policies that promote health and prevent disease.

The following data tables present the results from the 11 ACE questions and two protective childhood experiences (PCE) questions included in the 2022 ACE module. All 13 questions in the module refer to events that happened during the respondent's childhood (before they were 18 years of age). Research has shown that experiencing a high number of ACEs increases the risk for a variety of chronic physical and mental health conditions in adulthood. Of the total 13,393 Florida adults who completed the 2022 survey, 9,633 completed at least one question in the ACE module and are included in the prevalence estimates for the individual ACE and PCE indicators in this report. There were 8,779 respondents who completed all 13 questions in the module and are included in the prevalence estimates of the number of ACEs experienced (0 ACEs, 1 ACE, 2-3 ACEs or 4 or more ACEs). Responses of once or more than once to the five questions in the module regarding the number of times a respondent witnessed physical abuse between adults or experienced physical, emotional or sexual abuse were combined and treated as equivalent to a response of yes for the purpose of calculating the number of ACEs experienced. Responses of never to the two questions in the module regarding feeling safe and protected and having basic needs met by an adult in the household were each classified as experiencing an ACE. Each ACE and PCE indicator was analyzed by sex, race/ethnicity, age, education, income and marital status. All prevalence rates are weighted by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to represent all Florida adults. Weighting is a procedure that adjusts for the chance of an adult being selected to complete the survey and for discrepancies between the adults who completed the survey and the overall population of Florida adults. The data were weighted to the respondent's probability of selection by county, as well as age, sex, marital status, race/ethnicity, education level and housing type.

Due to a change in weighting methodology and the inclusion of cellular telephone responses starting in 2011, data from 2022 may not be comparable to data collected before 2011.
