Patient Care Services for Franklin and Gulf Counties in Florida

PREGNANCY & PARENTING SUPPORT SERVICES

Programs that provide education and support for pregnancy, breastfeeding, parenting, and child development.

HEALTHY FOODS AT NO COST

Women, Infants and Children's program for your growing family. Children are eligible until age 5.

FAMILY PLANNING SERVICES

A variety of birth control options are available, including permanent methods such as tubal ligation and vasectomy.

BREAST & CERVICAL SCREENINGS

Clinical breast exams, pap smear tests, and mammogram referrals available for all women.

The Florida Breast & Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program is available for women ages 50-64 with low income and no health insurance.

PREGNANCY TESTING & COUNSELING

Pregnancy testing and counseling is available to all women of reproductive age to facilitate early entry into prenatal care.

IMMUNIZATIONS

Helping your family stay healthy and up to date on their vaccines. Babies, children and adult appointments are available.

STD TESTING & TREATMENT

Promoting sexual health education, early disease detection and timely treatment. Includes HIV testing and PrEP.

SCHOOL & SPORTS PHYSICALS

These exams assess a child's health to ensure they are physically fit to attend a school or participate in athletic activities.

If the school year is coming up quickly and you haven't had time to schedule an appointment with your regular pediatrician, don't worry! We offer sports and school physicals for walk-in patients.

INSURANCE & COST OF SERVICES

We accept Medicaid, Medicare, and most 3rd party insurances. Many of our service fees are based on a sliding fee scale.
