

REVIEW STANDARDS FOR TATTOO EDUCATIONAL COURSES – BASIC DESIGN

1. Credentials of trainers and of persons compiling curriculum provided			
2. Copies of training materials provided			
3. Specific to the tattoo industry			
4. Classroom-based or Internet-based			
5. Excluding test, minimum 3 hours dedicated to BBP and communicable diseases			
6. Subject-matter expert available to answer questions (for Internet, can be available by phone or via electronic means during normal business hours)			
7. Test consists of at least 50 questions			
8. 70% is minimum passing score on test			
9. Copy of test provided			
10. Copy of test answers provided			
11. Copy of course certificate, which includes student name, a certificate serial number, and date of issuance provided			
12. Course and test (whether classroom or Internet) ensure identity verification and validation of student			
13. For Internet course, each course section has minimum time to finish before moving on to next section			
14. For Internet course, student-identity verification occurs prior to course initiation using technology that seeks verification through Internet databases using information that is specific to the student's identity			
15. Subsequently, for Internet course, student-identity validation occurs at least every hour during course and also prior to completing test			
16. For Internet course, automatically terminates when student fails to answer validation question during 60-second response time period, or student provides more than one incorrect answer to a question			
17. Subsequently, for Internet course, student may not re-register for one hour			
18. For Internet course, includes on the registration form initial blocks in which the student indicates agreement with the following information:			
a. Student who registers for course is person taking course			
b. Time-limited identity validation questions will be asked during course			
c. Validation questions will ask student questions about themselves based on information provided by them and obtained through Internet databases, as in 14 above			
d. Failure by student to answer an identity validation question during a 60-second response time period or student providing more than one incorrect answer to a question will cause course to terminate			
e. Upon such termination, a 1-hour waiting period is required before the student is allowed to register again			
19. For Internet course, student shall be prevented from proceeding with course should they fail to agree with each item listed in (18)			
20. Reference to DOH approval shall state no more than: "This course is approved by the Florida Department of Health for tattoo artist licensure under section 381.0775, F. S., and Chapter 64E-28, F. A. C."
