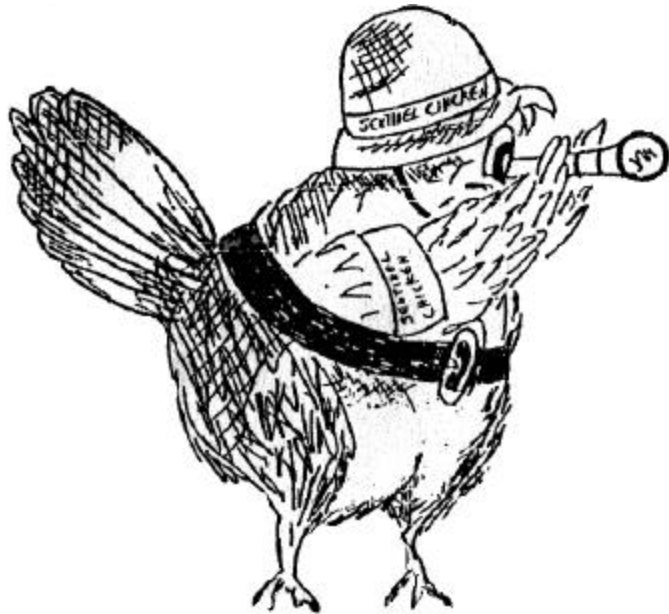

Arbovirus Surveillance Annual Report 1999

The State of Florida performs Arbovirus Surveillance throughout the year

- * These results are produced through a collaborative effort of many agencies and bureaus .
- * Sentinel Flocks are maintained by County Health Departments and Mosquito Control Districts throughout the state.
- * Sera are submitted to the Tampa Branch Laboratory, Florida Department of Health Bureau of Laboratories for assay.
- * The Hemagglutination Inhibition Assay for antibody to St. Louis Encephalitis virus (SLE) and Eastern Equine Encephalitis virus (EEE) are performed weekly by the laboratory.
- * The DOH Bureau of Epidemiology coordinates and leads the response made to increased virus activity.

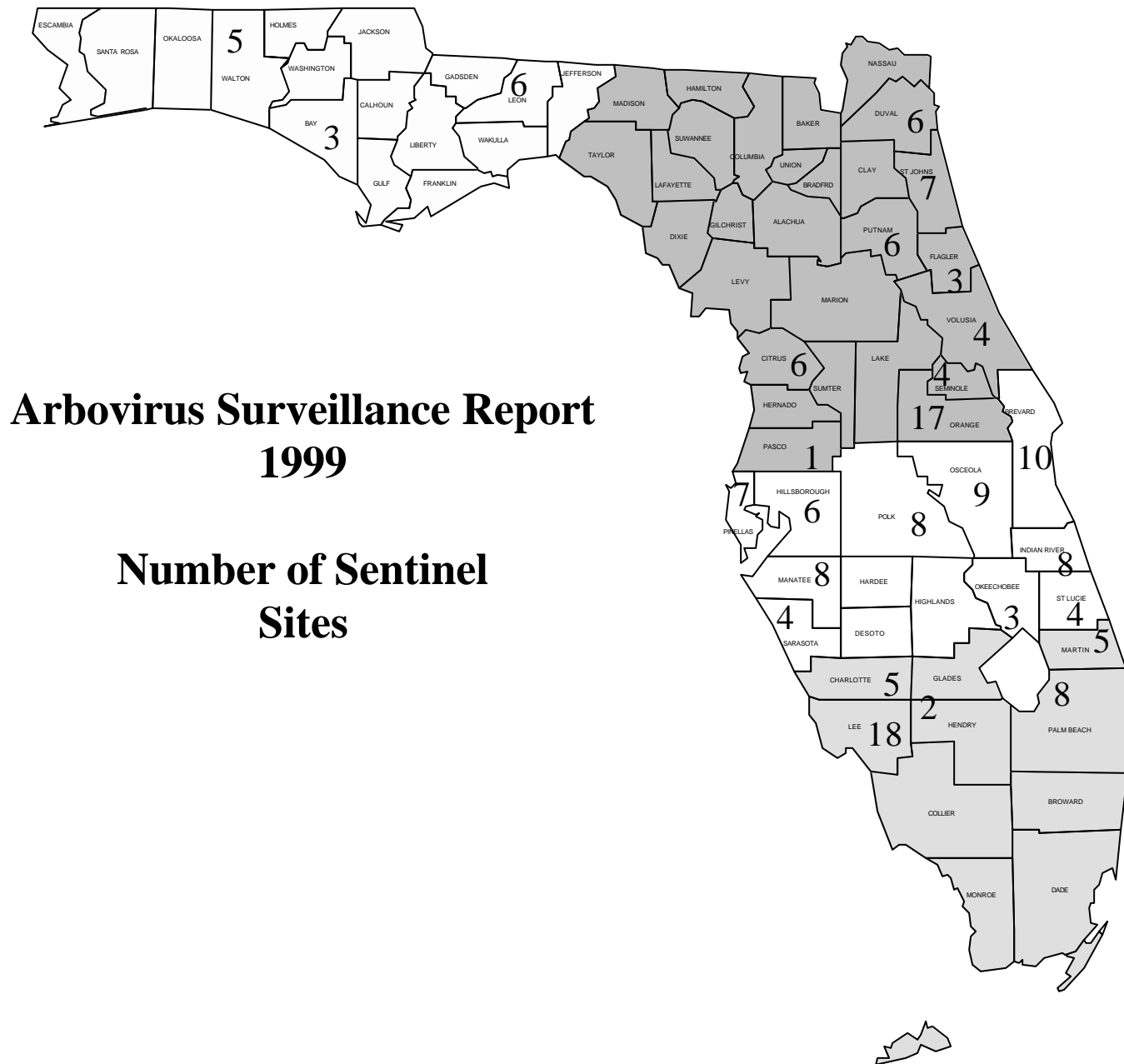

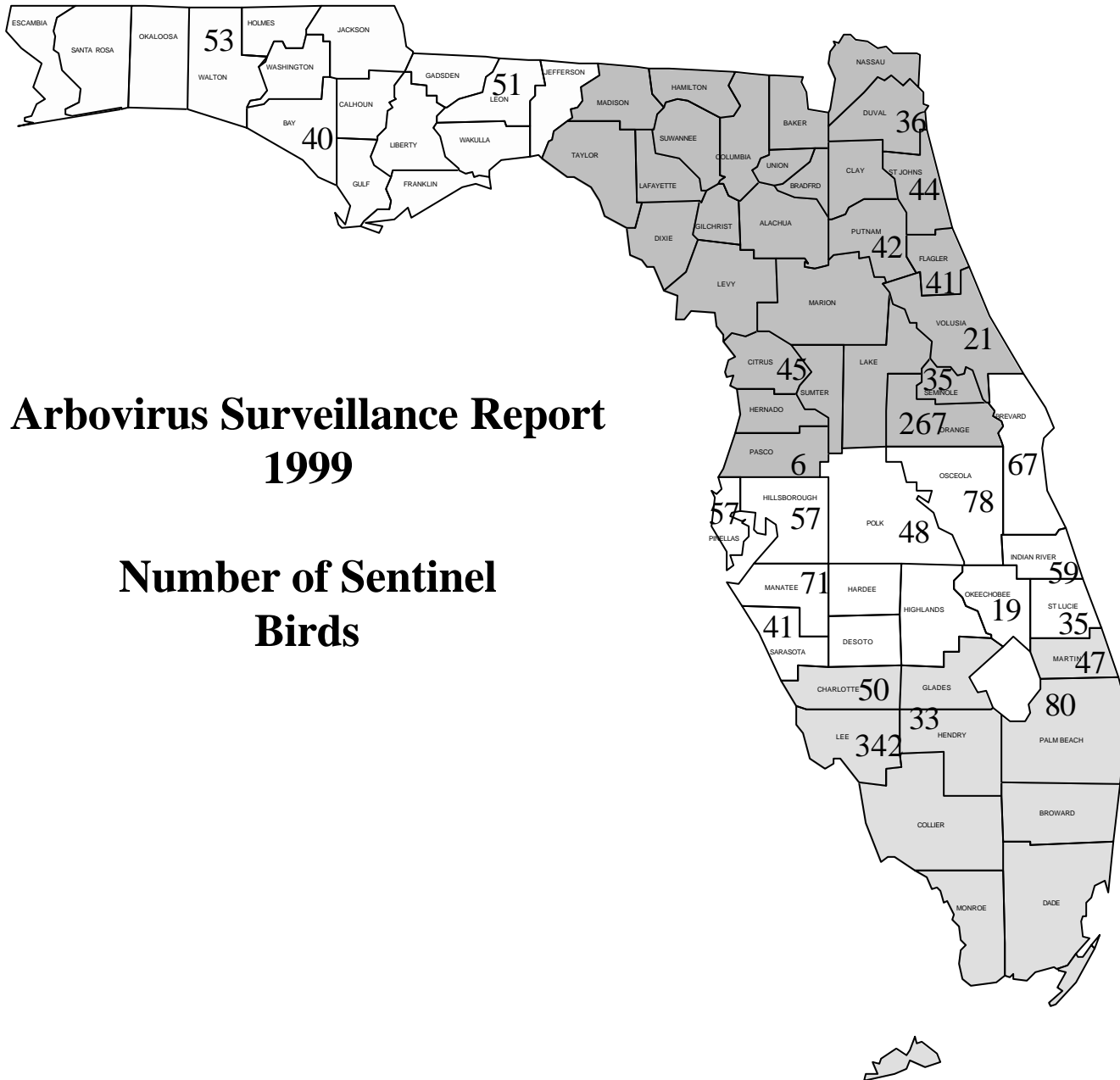

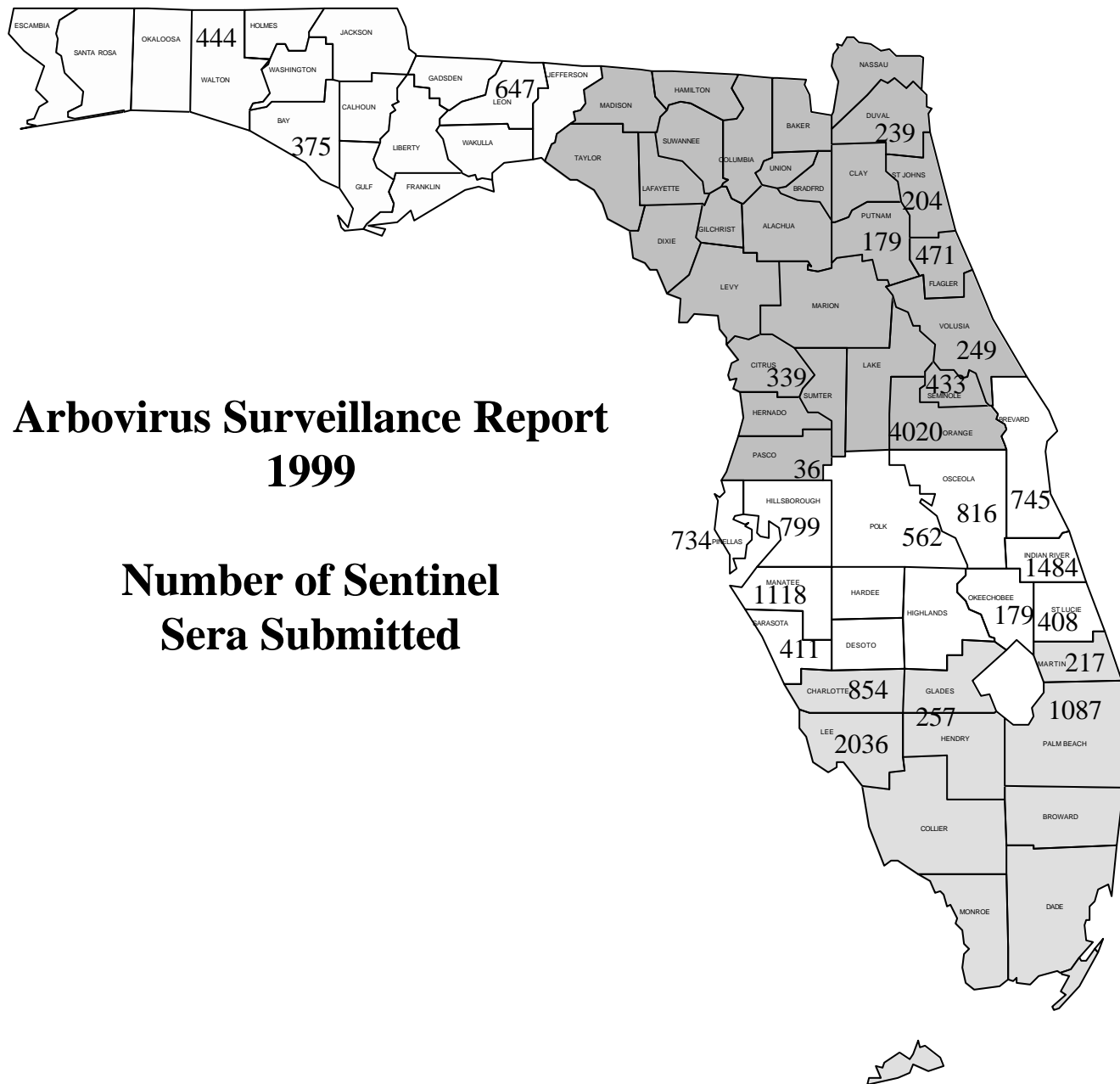
Arbovirus Surveillance Report 1999

Birds**

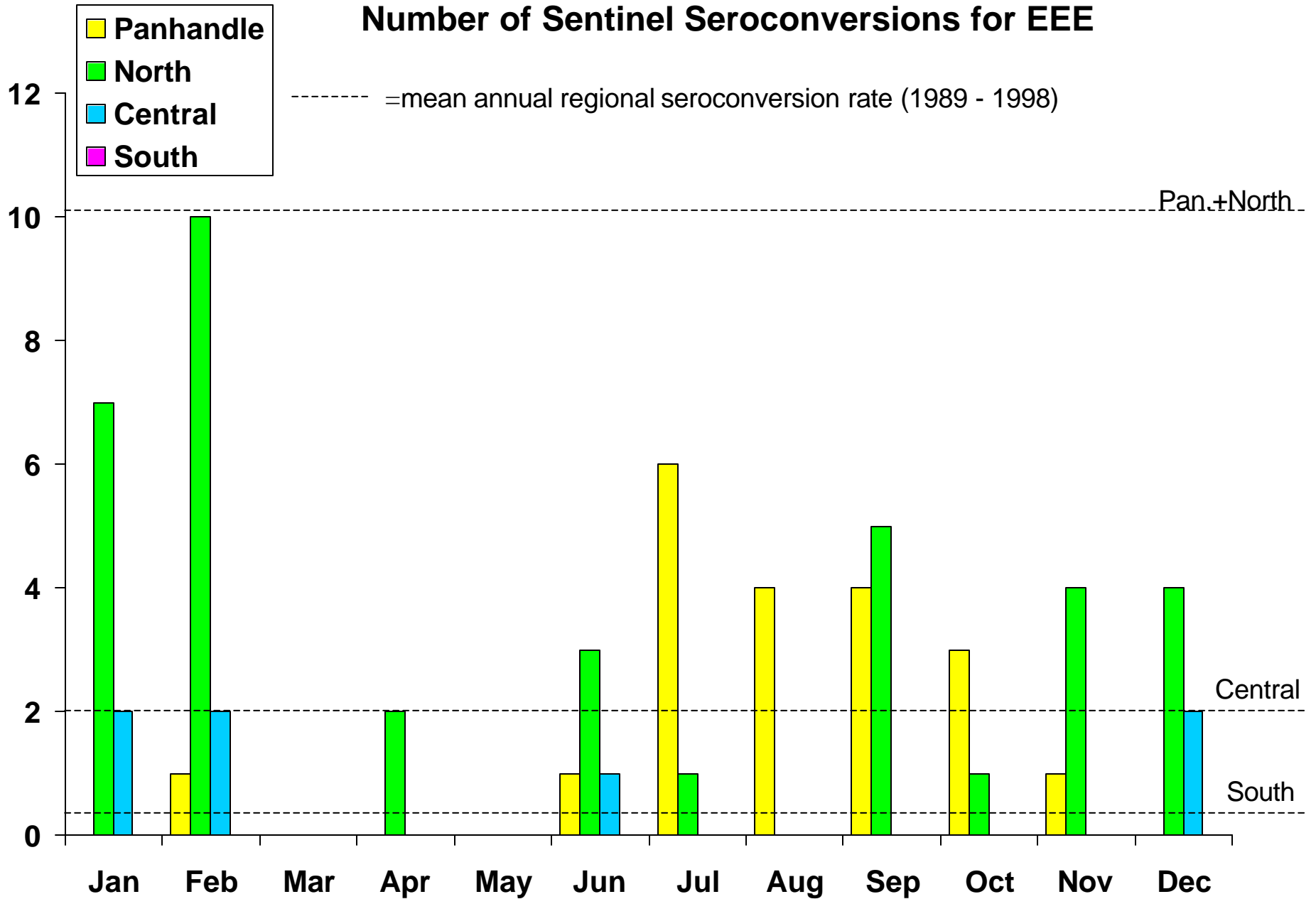

Number of Sentinel Sera Submitted

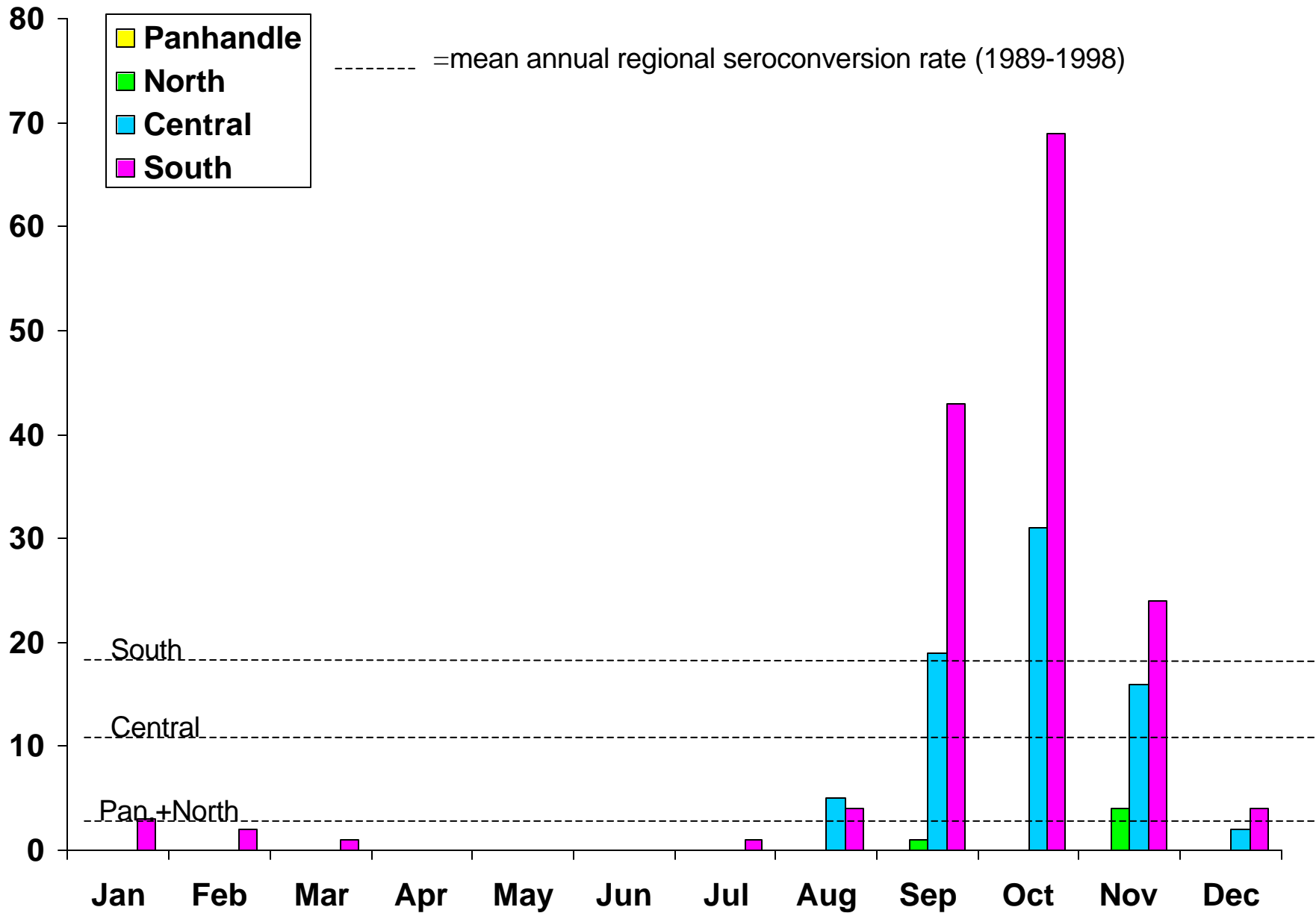
