

Registered Pharmacy Technician Continuing Education Information

Registered Pharmacy Technicians must obtain continuing education hours in order to renew the license in 2012. Any hours obtained from January 1, 2010 can be used for the renewal of the license.

Please find listed below the continuing education requirements for the Registered Pharmacy Technician license.

First Time Renewal within 12 months of expiration of license (1 Hour of Aids)

First Time Renewal more than 12 months prior to the expiration date of the license- The requirement is 12 hours - 1 HIV, 2 MED Errors, 9 General Total of 12 (4 of which must be live)

All courses must be approved by the ACPE or Florida Board of Pharmacy.

The 1 hour HIV/AIDS course must be taken from a Florida approved provider. Any HIV/AIDS course that is taken from a provider who has not been Florida Board approved will not be accepted.
