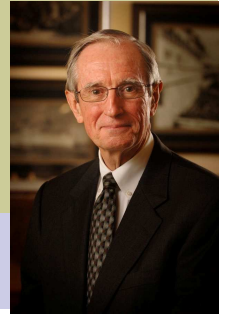


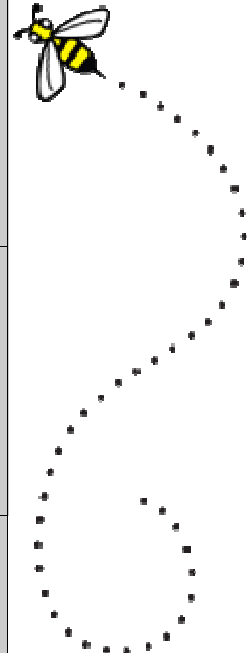
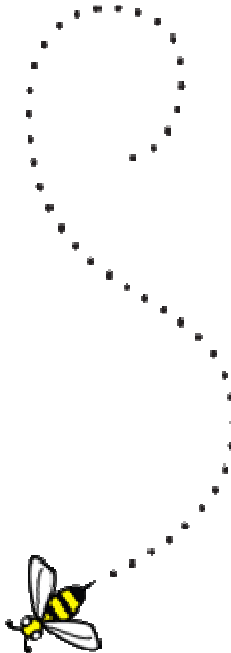
# What's the "Sugar-Buzz"
