

# INDIAN RIVER CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

## PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH SURVEY FINDINGS REQUIRING OHS INTERVENTION

In addition to the physical health findings of Indian River Correctional Institution referenced in the main body of the survey report (which fall within the scope of the institutional staff to correct), one other area of concern was noted. This finding is based on standards adopted by the CMA, but not addressed in OHS policy, procedure, or directive, or is related to other issues beyond institutional control. Therefore, corrective action at the institutional level can be initiated only by or with the authority or intervention of the OHS.

The item listed below identifies the finding, the name of the audit instrument used by CMA surveyors and the specific screen number, if applicable.

### PHYSICAL HEALTH

1. **Special housing inmates are not offered one hour of exercise per day, outside the cell five days per week.** This standard is referenced in the CMA Administrative Review Instrument, Question 23.
