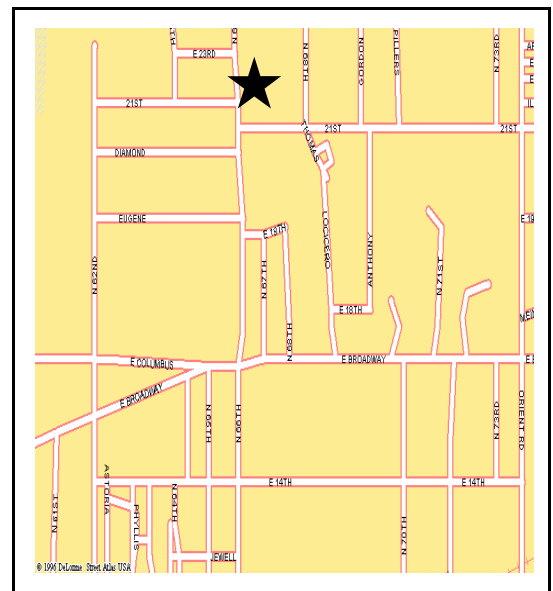
Florida Department of Health (FDOH)

- Most of the children tested had normal blood lead results. We sent letters to all parents of the group of children who were tested giving them the test results.
- A few children tested this month had blood lead results slightly above the normal range. The FDOH called their parents to inform them. These children will be retested in three months to see if their levels have changed.
- We gave guidance to parents for preventing lead exposure. We suggested a few visit their doctors.

This Open House is for residents living nearby the Gulf Coast Recycling site (GCR), inside an area bounded by N. 62nd Street, N. 66th Street, East Broadway, and the railroad tracks south of there.

Please bring all of your questions to the Open House Monday, August 30, 1999. You will get specific answers from the people who work at the various agencies and GCR. You can meet and talk with representatives of the Florida Department of Health (FDOH), the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), the Environmental Protection Commission (EPC), and GCR. You can speak with each of them individually and get personal answers to your questions.
