A PowerPoint presentation has been prepared for the purpose of delivering a full report of the PACE survey results to the community.

Progress on establishing the GIS information repository site continues. It will have the ability to generate user-friendly reports. The final set-up of the site is expected to be completed within 2 weeks.

Five historically relevant sites in East Jacksonville were selected for application for national recognition as a historical site. Applications were sent to the Bureau of Historic Preservation in Tallahassee. St. Joseph's United Methodist Church has shown promise in making it through to the National level for application as an historical site.
