

## Steven P. Rosenberg, MD

Steven P. Rosenberg, MD is a Board Certified Dermatologist practicing in West Palm Beach since 1980. He obtained his MD from Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York in 1975 and trained in Internal Medicine in Los Angeles at UCLA-Harbor General Hospital and at Montefiore Hospital in New York. Prior to his dermatology residency training, Dr. Rosenberg volunteered through Option AmDoc by providing medical services at remote hospitals and clinics in Irrua, Nigrieria and Kendu Bay, Kenya as well as at a Leprosy colony in Sikonge, Tanzania. He completed his residency in Dermatology at the University of Miami and was Chief Resident in 1979. Dr. Rosenberg has continued to teach at the medical school and is currently a Clinical Professor of Dermatology and Cutaneous Surgery at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine and at Florida Atlantic University School of Medicine where he lectures medical students and teaches residents. He has been Chief of Dermatology at St. Mary's/ Good Samaritan Hospitals.

Awards include Practitioner of the Year from the Florida Society of Dermatology 1993-1994 and the Distinguished Service Award in 1997. He has been listed in Best Doctors in America since 1996 as well as listed by his peers in Palm Beach Life, South Florida Magazine, and Florida Trend Magazine's survey of best doctors. He founded and is President of Palm Beach Dermatology, Inc. which employs 15 board certified physicians, the largest dermatology group practice in Palm Beach County. It was voted "Best Group Practice" by South Florida Medical Business.

Dr. Rosenberg has also been president of the Palm Beach County Dermatology Society and President of the Florida Society of Dermatology and Dermatologic Surgery. He is involved with various community activities and has been on the Board of the Palm Beach County Cultural Council and the Board of the South Florida Science Museum serving as Chairman of the Board from 1997-1998. He also has served on the Board of Trustees of the Palm Beach County Medical Society, The Florida Society of Dermatology and Dermatologic Surgery as well as the Richard David Kahn Melanoma Foundation.

Dr. Rosenberg received national attention by successfully coordinating legislative efforts to obtain Direct Access to Dermatologists legislation in Florida. He was featured on 20/20 when he represented the dermatologists who were critical of HMO selected pathology laboratories; as a result most managed care companies now allow dermatologists to utilize laboratories specializing in skin pathology. Recently he coordinated the passage of a bill requiring greater physician supervision of satellite medical clinics, offices and medical spas. Dr. Rosenberg received the Political Leadership Award from Florida Medical Business in 1998.

Dr. Rosenberg is particularly interested in improving the public's access to quality health care. In 1995 Governor Chiles appointed Dr. Rosenberg to the Governor's Physician Advisory Input Panel on Health Care Issues and in 1997 Governor Chiles appointed him to the State of Florida's Advisory Panel on Health Care. Governor Jeb Bush appointed Dr. Rosenberg to the Board of Medicine in 2006 and Governor Charlie Crist reappointed him in 2007 for a 4 year term. This is the first time a dermatologist has served on the 12 doctor panel in more than 30 years. He currently serves on the PA council, the Surgical Care Committee, and the Rules and Legislative Committee which he chairs. His goal is to make certain that rules protect Floridians' access to quality health care.
