*Contacted all counties that had several programs under one code which were not in compliance.

*Board is enforcing Florida Statute 464.203 pertaining to requiring proof of completing a Board approved program if under 18.

*Board has provided information on program renewal via seminar, website, mailman and daily correspondence.

*Working closely with DOE and Prometric at informing the public about C.N.A. program renewal.

C.N.A. Program Issues:

*Board needs to enforce rule 64B9-15.005 (6)F.A.C. -A training program must maintain a passing rate on certified nursing assistant examination for its graduates of not less than 10% below the state average as reported annually.

*Currently, applicants may be testing under a Board approved program code, even if they did not attend the program. This process may be negatively affecting Board approved program passage rates.

*Some Board approved programs that are currently testing are not in compliance with program renewal requirements.

*Program renewal rule 64B9-15.005 (11) needs updating and clarification.

*There needs to be a clear distinction between compliant programs and noncompliant programs, and the Board needs to decide what to do with programs that do not timely renew. Will this decision be retroactive so that the total CNA program list can be cleaned up?

*Board must implement process to require documentation of completion of Board approved program.

*All CNA programs that are in compliance must be entered into COMPAS so that Board staff can locate new program code and send it to Prometric once program has been confirmed as being in compliance.

*Board must notify programs of new processes.

*Perhaps Prometric should change application so that applicants may only select an option for “challenger” or “Board approved program”.

*The Board of Nursing, DOE and Prometric must be consistent in providing information to the public pertaining to program renewal and requiring proof of program completion.

Current processes in place to improve CNA program issues:

As of July 1, 2011, the Board of Nursing will begin requesting that all Board approved CNA programs provide school lists, documenting the students that have successfully completed their program. If an applicant indicates that they completed an approved program, their name must be on that list.

Board staff will have assigned new codes and entered all current and compliant programs into COMPAS by July 1, 2011.

Once all current and compliant programs have been assigned new codes and processes are in place to ensure that only students who completed a Board approved program are testing under that program’s code, then the Board can begin to enforce rule 64B9-15.005 (6)F.A.C.

Board staff will send out a mass email via our Mailman list server or another listserv, including information pertaining to program renewal, new processes for sending in school lists, updated requirements, information on the new background process, etc.

Revised new program application and renewal application forms have been provided to the AG staff, but these forms must be included in rule.

The Board of Nursing hosted the second CNA Program Educator’s seminar on May 31, 2011.
