

SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORT FOR TRAINING
RURAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL

The Florida Office of Rural Health provided \$20,000 in grant funds to the Florida Association of Rural Emergency Medical Services (FAREMS) to assist in providing scholarships to train paramedics and emergency medical technicians in Florida's rural counties. FAREMS is a statewide network composed of licensed EMS provider organizations from rural counties that provides support and assistance to its members to address rural EMS issues such as recruitment and retention, medical director coverage, and training of rural EMS personnel.
